# ÉTAT D'URGENCE: a refugee camp in downtown Montreal NOVEMBER 23-27, 2005, at PLACE ÉMILIE-GAMELIN (Berri-UQAM metro)

A celebration of solidarity, and a creative space focused on social cohesion.

État d'Urgence is an annual rendez-vous with and in the street orchestrated by ATSA since 1998 in collaboration with numerous artists and private and public organizations. Looking like a refugee camp smack dab in the core of the wealthy metropolis, it is a meeting ground whose aim is to stimulate socially engaged art and solidarity between people of all stripes.

État d'Urgence represents \$50,000 worth of warm clothes for street people, three meals per day including sitdown meals for 150 people and a 24-hour snack table, nighttime sleeping quarters, and top-calibre, multidisciplinary and free programming showcasing artists who give of themselves generously, all in a festive environment. It is an unforgettable experience for all involved, bridging the gaps between the different social realities and bringing together various cultural media in the camp's daily goings-on. The realistic setting occupies Place Émilie-Gamelin (Berri-UQAM metro) in its entirety, under two heated big tops open to all, around the clock. Outside, braziers warm up the crowd, who can view the action taking place inside the tents on a giant video screen.

État d'Urgence is a *manifestival*, a committed and multidisciplinary setting in which to discover artists in another light, in a climate of sharing and social cohesion; no artifice, just one-to-one human contact making for a unique experience. Get involved!
