Monday, November 7, 2011 - A LARGE GATHERING for the opening night of **FIN NOVEMBRE!**

Following a flamboyant circus performance by the troupe **Fogorasto**, ATSA invites the public to be part of a **big, cathartic, collective gesture**, tightly organized (virtually choreographed), **filmed and integrated** into a huge video installation titled *Quand en aurez-vous assez!* to be screened from dusk to dawn at Place Émilie-Gamelin until November 27.

This video installation, of which you will be a protagonist, shall bear witness to the fact that though there may be no État d'Urgence this year, there remain 30,000 homeless persons on the streets of Montreal and a widening wealth gap around the world. The video installation will loudly denounce this indecent disparity. What does it mean to have had enough? When will we, as individuals and as a society, recognize the obscenity of allowing people to live out on the street or in poverty while financiers rake in billions in profits (when they are not making the world come crashing down)?

ATSA will be featured in the first part of the video, but the public will have the last word during the second part, to be filmed November 18 and integrated into the first part! This collective gesture will be a response to the indecent wealth gap, a call to action, a show of hope...

After the festive video shoot, we will continue the celebration with a show featuring **Paul Cargnello, Ivy, WLOVE, Isabelle St-Pierre, David Marin, Ève Cournoyer** and a few surprises! Hosted by none other than **François Gourd and Toxique Trottoir!** **WE EXPECT YOU TO COME OUT IN LARGE NUMBERS!**

These evening gatherings will also be an opportunity for ATSA to collect and distribute appropriate donations for street people, with surplus going to Montreal's shelters.
